**FINAL ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR LICENSE**

NOW ON THIS 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 2024, comes on for hearing with due and proper notice, the matter of the application of Neda Gilmartin, M.D. for an active license to practice medicine and surgery. Applicant Neda Gilmartin, M.D. appears in person *pro se*. Richard Bradbury, D.P.M., President of the Board, appears with a lawfully convened Board. Bradley Taylor, Deputy General Counsel, presents the status of the application to the Board.

**I. Summary of Proceedings**

For purposes of licensure by endorsement, although Applicant has an active license in Ohio, she does not meet active practice requirements. Notwithstanding, for purposes of licensure by examination consideration, Applicant has presented proof of successful completion of at least 36 months of postgraduate training. The board considered whether at least 36 months of Applicant's postgraduate training is approved

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by the council on medical education of the American medical association, or the substantial equivalent, as determined by the board. The board has determined Applicant meets technical requirements for licensure.

## II. Facts

1. Applicant graduated from Free University of Brussels Medical School in Belgium in 2004.

2. Applicant is ECFMG certified, issued 2018.

3. Applicant is actively licensed in Ohio, effective 8/7/24.

4. From 2004 (medical school graduation year) through 2015 Applicant completed additional postgraduate training in Belgium and the United Kingdom.

5. Between 2015 and 2018 Applicant moved to California, completed medical examination preparation and successfully completed USMLE Steps, 1, 2, CK, and CS during this time.

6. During 2016, Applicant completed an observorship with spine surgeon Dr. Hooman Melamed.

7. From 2019 to 2020, Applicant volunteered at the Orthopedic Institute for Children writing reports and case papers. Applicant also passed USMLE Step 3 in 2020.

8. Applicant then completed 2 years of postgraduate training (PGT) between 2020 and 2022 at Norton Leatherman Spine Center in Louisville Kentucky, 1 year of PGT from 2022 to 2023 at University of Arizona College of Medicine-Tucson

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Program in Arizona, and another year of training between 2023 to 2024 at UCI Medical Center in California.

9. Applicant has demonstrated a reasonable ability to communicate in English.

### III. Legal Conclusions

**Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833**, for purposes of applications for licensure by endorsement, the Board, may issue a license to a person who has been in the active practice of a branch of the healing arts in some other state or country upon certificate of the proper licensing authority for that state or country that applicant's license has never been limited, suspended, revoked, or disciplined. Further, the applicant shall present proof that the applicant has been actively engaged in practice under such license or licenses since issued.

**Additionally, pursuant to K.A.R. 100-8-3**, applicants seeking licensure by endorsement based on licensure must have been actively practicing in the 12 months immediately preceding the application, consisting of either at least one full day per week for at least 50 weeks, a total of 400 hours, or the substantial equivalent as determined by the Board. Based on the above, the board finds that Applicant does not meet technical requirements for licensure by endorsement due to not actively practicing for the 12 months preceding her application. Notwithstanding, as noted below, the board has determined Applicant meets technical requirements for licensure by examination.

**Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-6-2(c)**, for purposes of licensure by examination, each applicant for licensure by examination in medicine and surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery who graduates from an unaccredited school of medicine before January 1, 2021, shall present proof of successful completion of at least 36 months of a postgraduate training program or residency training program. This program shall have been approved by the council on medical education of the American medical association, the American osteopathic association, or the substantial equivalent, as determined by the board, in the year in which the training took place.

**Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-7-1**, applicants for licensure by examination shall be required to successfully complete Steps 1, 2, and 3 of the United States medical licensing examination (USMLE) or the substantial equivalent in the year of the examination as determined by the board.

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**Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-6-5**, foreign medical graduates shall meet the requirements and received a standard certificate from the educational council for foreign medical graduates, present proof their medical school meets minimum standards, and the applicant must have a reasonable ability to communicate in English.

The Board finds that the Applicant meets the requirements for licensure by examination and **GRANTS the APPLICATION** with an effective date of February 5, 2025.
