SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 11th day of March, 2025, this matter comes before Susan Gile, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), in summary proceedings under K.S.A. 77-537.

Under K.S.A 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, this Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, if no written request for a hearing is made within 15 days of service. Upon review of the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about November 23, 2009, the Board issued License No. 04-34107 to Scott T. Roethle, M.D. (“Licensee”) to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas. Licensee last renewed such license on or about June 10, 2024. Licensee’s license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas is currently Active.

Summary Order

3. On or about June 26, 2020, Licensee entered into a Stipulation and Order with the Idaho State Board of Medicine (the “Idaho Order”). (Bd. Ex. 1: Idaho Order).

4. Per the Idaho Order, Licensee stipulated and agreed he was being disciplined for “failing to prescribe and provide treatment to Idaho patients within the scope of the Medical Practice Act and the Idaho Telehealth Access Act.” (*Id.*)

5. The Idaho Order publicly reprimanded Licensee for the above misconduct. (*Id.*)

APPLICABLE LAW

6. Under K.S.A. 65-2836(j) of the Kansas Healing Arts Act (the “Act”), a licensee's license may be revoked, suspended or limited, or the licensee may be publicly censured or placed under probationary conditions upon a finding that the licensee “has had a license to practice the healing arts revoked, suspended or limited, has been censured or has had other disciplinary action taken, or an application for a license denied, by the proper licensing authority of another state, territory, District of Columbia, or other country.”

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. The Board has jurisdiction over the Licensee as well as the subject matter of this proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.

8. Based on the facts and circumstances set forth herein, the use of summary proceedings in this matter is appropriate, in accordance with the provisions set forth in K.S.A. 77-537(a), in that the use of summary proceedings does not violate any provision of law, and the protection of the public interest does not require the Board to give notice and opportunity to participate to non-parties.

9. The Board finds that Licensee is subject to discipline under K.S.A. 65-2836(j) of the Act, in that Licensee has had disciplinary action taken against a license to practice the healing arts by the proper licensing authority of another state, to-wit: Licensee was publicly reprimanded by the Idaho State Board of Medicine.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee is **PUBLICLY CENSURED** under K.S.A. 65-2836(j) of the Kansas Healing Arts Act from the date this Order becomes effective as a Final Order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that upon becoming effective as a Final Order, this document shall be deemed a public record and be reported to any reporting entities authorized to receive such disclosure.
