ORDER AFFIRMING 90 DAY SUSPENSION

NOW on this 14th day of February 2025, upon due and proper notice, comes on for hearing the question of whether Aman K. Patel, D.O.'s suspension, previously ordered for 90 days and commencing January 9, 2025, should be shortened. The parties enter their appearance as follows: Aman K. Patel, D.O. appears virtually. Matthew Gaus, representing the Disciplinary Panel (DP # 39), appears in person. Immediately upon call of the case, the Board voted unanimously to appoint members of the Board who are present and not recused to serve as presiding officer and render an order pursuant to K.S.A. 77-514(g). Mark Balderston, D.C., Richard Bradbury, DP.M., Thomas; Estep, M.D., David Jordan, and Ronald Varner, D.O. are recused. Amana Patel testifies on his own behalf. The Court Reporter swore in Aman Patel, D.O. before testifying.

Upon due consideration of the law, the evidence, and all matters before the tribunal, the Presiding Officer FINDS AND ORDERS as follows:

1. The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC), K.S.A. 65-28,133(d) mandates that an IMLC licensee is automatically and immediately suspended for a

period of 90 days from the date of the member State's order acknowledging another member State's suspension or revocation of an IMLC license.

2. Kansas is a member of the IMLC.
3. Aman Patel, D.O. is a licensee under the IMLC.
4. Maryland suspended Dr. Patel's license on October 23, 2024.
5. In turn and as required by the IMLC, Kansas summarily suspended Dr. Patel's license for 90-days.

6. Dr. Patel requested a hearing on the order of suspension and requested to appear virtually at the time of the hearing.

7. At the hearing, Dr. Patel, under oath said that he was not arguing to lift the suspension. He added that the 90-day suspension was "O.K." He also gave the Board a status report on the complaints against him.

WHEREUPON, the Presiding Officer affirms the 90-day suspension, having been presented with no basis for the suspension's termination. The 90-day suspension that commenced on January 8, 2025, continues unabated.
