SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 10th day of April, 2025, this matter comes before Susan Gile, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings under K.S.A. 77-537.

Under K.S.A 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, this Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, if no written request for a hearing is made within 15 days of service. Upon review of the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

Findings of Fact

1. Aman K. Patel, D.O. ("Licensee") is or, at all times relevant hereto, has been licensed to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Kansas, having been granted an Active license through the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, K.S.A. 65-28,133 ("IMLC"), on April 14, 2022. Licensee's current license designation is "Active." Licensee last renewed this license on October 9, 2024.

2. Licensee's last mailing address known to the Board is **CONFIDENTIAL**.

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3. Licensee's State of Principal License under the IMLC is Texas. (Bd. Ex. 1 – IMLC Renewal 2024, p. 1).

4. Licensee is, or at all times relevant hereto has been, licensed to practice osteopathic medicine in Texas, having been granted License No. Q-8994 on or about July 1, 2016. This license is valid through August 1, 2026. (Bd. Ex. 2 – Texas Medical Board Verification)

5. Licensee is, or at all times relevant hereto has been, licensed to practice osteopathic medicine in Maryland, having been granted a license to practice by the Maryland State Board of Physicians (“the Maryland Board”) on or about April 19, 2022. This license is valid through September 30, 2025. (Bd. Ex. 3 – Maryland Order for Summary Suspension, p. 2).

6. The Maryland Board, the Texas Board of Medicine (“Texas Board”) and the Kansas Board of Healing Arts are “member boards” as defined by K.S.A. 65-28,133, Section 2(h) of the IMLC.

7. On or about October 23, 2024, the Maryland Board issued an Order for Summary Suspension of License to Practice Medicine (“Maryland Order for Summary Suspension”) that immediately suspended Licensee's license to practice medicine in Maryland for an indefinite period, upon a finding “that the public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action”. (*Id.* at pp. 9-10).

8. On or about October 24, 2024, The Texas Board summarily and indefinitely suspended Licensee's license to practice in that state based on the Maryland Order for Summary Suspension. To the best of knowledge and belief, this suspension remains in effect. (Bd. Ex. 4 – Texas Notice of Board Action)

Applicable Law

9. Under K.S.A. 65-28,133, Section 10(b) of the IMLC:

“If a license granted to a physician by the member board in the state of principal license is revoked, surrendered or relinquished in lieu of discipline, or suspended, then all licenses issued to the physician by member boards shall automatically be placed, without further action necessary by any member board, on the same status. If the member board in the state of principal license subsequently reinstates the physician's license, a license issued to the physician by any other member board shall remain encumbered until that respective member board takes action to reinstate the license in a manner consistent with the medical practice act of that state.”
[emphasis added]

Conclusions of Law

10. The Board has jurisdiction over Licensee as well as the subject matter of this proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.

11. On or about October 24, 2024, the Texas Board, a member board of the IMLC, and Licensee's designated state of principal license, suspended Licensee's license to practice osteopathic medicine.

12. Under K.S.A. 65-28,133 Section 10(b) of the IMLC, because Licensee's license to practice osteopathic medicine was indefinitely suspended by Licensee's IMLC state of principal licensure, the Board must automatically place Licensee's license on the same status – that is, it must be indefinitely suspended.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee's license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Kansas is **INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED** from the date this Order becomes effective as a Final Order.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the indefinite suspension shall remain in place, at a minimum, until the Texas Board terminates the suspension of Licensee's license to practice in that state. Following the termination of such suspension, Licensee may petition the Board to terminate his suspended Kansas license in accordance with the Kansas Healing Arts Act (K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.*), the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*), and any and all other Kansas statutes and regulations governing the practice of osteopathic medicine and surgery in this state.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that upon becoming effective as a Final Order, this document shall be deemed a public record and be reported to any reporting entities authorized to receive such disclosure.
