FINAL ORDER TO REMOVE RESTRICTIONS

NOW ON the filed stamped date shown on this Order, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) considers the Motion to Terminate Final Order. The hearing in this matter was held on April 11, 2025. Caitlin Kremer appeared on behalf of Disciplinary Panel #34 and in person at the hearing. The Licensee appears in person. Upon due consideration of the facts and circumstances in this matter the Board FINDS AS FOLLOWS AND ORDERS:

1. Licensee is a radiologic technologist.
2. Leading up to the Board’s January 8, 2020, Final Order, Licensee disclosed in a renewal application that she had been arrested and charged with driving under the influence of alcohol, transportation of liquor in an open container, and failure to provide proof of liability insurance to operate a motor vehicle.
3. The incident giving rise to the charges occurred on January 14, 2018, when she was seen sitting in a damaged vehicle on the shoulder of westbound I-70.
4. Following a hearing on December 13, 2019, the Board entered an order dated January 8, 2020, to include monitoring **CONFIDENTIAL** for a period of five years.

6. The January 8, 2020, Final Order required that the Licensee go before the Board to be released from the limitations on her License.
7. Licensee represents under oath at the hearing that she has complied with the terms and conditions of the January 8, 2020, Order in all respects.
8. Disciplinary Panel #34 does not object to her release.

In reliance on the representations made at the April 11, 2025, hearing by the Licensee, Licensee is RELEASED from the limitations from practice set out in the January 8, 2020, Final Order. Licensee must continue to adhere to the laws governing her license and her practice as a radiologic technician in all respects.
