**ORDER VACATING FINAL ORDER**

NOW, on this 3rd day of October 2025, Abebe Abebe, M.D., the lawfully appointed Presiding Officer (PO) in this matter, duly considers the Motion to Vacate the September 23, 2025, Final Order entered in this matter suspending the license of Dean V. Moesch, M.D. (Licensee). Upon due consideration, the Presiding Officer FINDS the following:

1. On July 30, 2025, the Board found that Licensee failed to provide legally requested information to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) and ordered that his license be suspended.
2. The next day, on July 31, 2025, Licensee provided legally requested information to the Board.
3. On August 4, 2025, the Board confirmed through staff that Licensee had complied with the Board's requests.

4. Licensee shows due cause for any delay in responding to the Board's request and was proactive in providing the missing information *prior* to the issuance of the Final Order.
5. The September 23, 2025, Final Order was issued in error.
6. Licensee complied with the Board's requests before the Final Order was filed, mooted the need for a hearing.
7. The legal doctrines of detrimental reliance and promissory estoppel do not generally apply to a governmental agency. However, in this case, the September 23, 2025, order was entered in error and is VACATED by the Board.
8. The Board shall send a copy of this order to any regulatory authorities or reporting agencies to which the Board sent a copy of the September 23, 2025, order.
9. The September 23, 2025, Final Order shall be removed from the Board's website.
