**ORDER GRANTING  
REQUEST TO LIFT SUSPENSION**

On October 10, 2025, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) conducted a conference hearing on the Request to Lift Suspension (“Request”) filed by Kalwant Singh, O.T. (“Licensee”). Jacob T. Overbey, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared in person as counsel for Disciplinary Panel No. 39 (“the Panel”). Licensee appeared in person, *pro se*.

1. On or about July 27, 1999, Licensee was first issued a Kansas occupational therapist license, No. 17-01717.

2. On or about July 7, 2025, the Board issued a Final Order finding Licensee had not completed the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA) course entitled “Detailing Documentation: Applying Documentation Strategies for Audit Success,” or a substantially similar program proposed by Licensee and approved by the Panel, within ninety (90) days of the May 10, 2024, execution of his Professional Development Plan (“PDP”), which required the same.

3. Pursuant to the Board’s July 7, 2025, Final Order, Licensee’s license was indefinitely suspended, and Licensee’s suspension was not to be lifted until Licensee complied with the Board’s directive to provide proof of successful completion of the above noted AOTA course or a substantially similar program proposed by Licensee and approved by the Panel.

4. On or about August 19, 2025, Licensee successfully completed the above noted AOTA course and Licensee provided to the Board a certificate of completion from AOTA for the same.

5. On or about September 24, 2025, Licensee filed a Request to Lift Suspension.

6. On or about September 25, 2024, the Panel filed a Response to Licensee's Request to Lift Suspension ("Response") in which the Panel indicated that it had no objection to Licensee's request to terminate his suspension.

8. Upon review of Licensee's Request, the Panel's Response, the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and the statements by the parties at the hearing, the Board finds that Licensee has fully complied with the terms of the Board's July 7, 2025, Final Order, and amendments thereto.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Licensee's Request to Lift Suspension is **GRANTED**, and the suspension of Licensee's license to practice occupational therapy in Kansas is **LIFTED**. This order does not obviate any ongoing requirements that would otherwise be required by Licensee to maintain his license in good standing with the Board.
