AMENDED CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW Disciplinary Panel No. 26 (the "Panel"), a duly constituted committee of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("the Board"), by and through Jacob T. Overbey, Associate Litigation Counsel, and Lamberto O. Flores, M.D. ("Licensee"), *pro se*, and move the Board for approval of this new Consent Order amending the Consent Order previously entered limiting Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas. The parties stipulate and agree to the following:

2. Licensee is or has been licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 04-34311 on or about April 13, 2010. Licensee last renewed such license on or about June 30, 2025. Licensee's license status is currently Active – Limited by Board Action. The limitation took effect on or about June 17, 2015.

3. A protective order is hereby entered to protect all confidential information under 42 CFR Part II and K.S.A. 65-4925.

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4. This Consent Order is based on the following facts, which the parties agree to and stipulate to be true and relevant to the requested relief:

- a. On or about May 27, 2011, Licensee performed a circumcision on a one-day old male at **CONFIDENTIAL**
- b. Following the circumcision, nursing staff expressed concerns that the skin along the shaft of the penis was removed all the way down to the base of the penis.
- c. Licensee returned to the OB unit to check on the infant. Licensee felt that the circumcision looked normal.

- f. On or about June 17, 2015, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board. This Consent Order limited Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas by limiting him from performing male circumcisions until he completed at least ten (10) hours of in-person continuing medical education, specifically in the area of male circumcisions, unless otherwise approved by Disciplinary Panel #26.
- g. Since entering the original Consent Order, Licensee has been unable to find at least ten (10) hours of in-person continuing medical education specifically in the area of male circumcisions, effectively preventing Licensee's completion of the original Consent Order's terms.

5. Licensee has committed an act or acts in violation of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and/or applicable rules and regulations adopted by the Board. Specifically:

- a. K.S.A. 65-2836(b), in that Licensee has committed act(s) of unprofessional or dishonorable conduct or professional incompetency;
- b. K.S.A. 65-2836(s), in that Licensee has had sanctions or disciplinary action taken against him by a peer review committee, health care facility, a governmental agency or department or a professional association or society for acts or conduct similar to acts or conduct which would constitute grounds for disciplinary action under this section; and
- c. K.S.A. 65-2836(u), in that Licensee has agreed to a limitation to or restriction of privileges at any medical care facility or has surrendered Licensee's membership on any professional staff or in any professional association or society while under investigation for acts or conduct similar to acts or conduct which would constitute grounds for disciplinary action under this section.

6. Licensee acknowledges he has violated the Kansas Healing Arts Act with respect to the above allegations. Licensee further waives his right to dispute or otherwise contest the allegations contained in the above paragraphs in any further proceeding before this Board.

7. Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives his right to a hearing. Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives his right to present a defense by oral testimony and documentary evidence, to submit rebuttal evidence, and to conduct cross-examination of witnesses. Licensee

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voluntarily and knowingly agrees to waive all possible substantive and procedural motions and defenses that could be raised if an administrative hearing were held.

8. All ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ materials ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ regarding Licensee were fully reviewed and considered by the Board members who serve on the Board's Disciplinary Panel No. 26. Disciplinary Panel No. 26 authorized and directed Board counsel to seek settlement of this matter with the provisions contained in this Consent Order.

9. As set forth in K.S.A. 65-2838(b) and K.S.A. 77-505, the Board has authority to enter into this Consent Order without the necessity of proceeding to a formal hearing.

10. The terms and conditions of the Consent Order are entered into between the undersigned parties and are submitted for the purpose of allowing these terms and conditions to become a lawful Order of the Board.

11. This Consent Order shall not be binding on the Board until an authorized signature is affixed at the end of this document. Licensee specifically acknowledges that counsel for the Panel is not authorized to sign this Consent Order on behalf of the Board.

12. The Board is the sole and exclusive administrative agency in the State of Kansas authorized to regulate the practice of medicine and surgery. K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*

13. The Kansas Healing Arts Act is constitutional on its face and as applied in this case. Licensee agrees that in considering this matter, the Board is not acting beyond its jurisdiction as provided by law.

14. Licensee hereby releases the Board, its individual members (in their official and personal capacity), attorneys, employees, and agents (collectively, "Releasees"), from any and all

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claims including, but not limited to, those alleged damages, actions, liabilities, both administrative and civil, including the Kansas Judicial Review Act, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.*, arising out of the investigation and acts leading to the execution of this Consent Order. This release shall forever discharge the Releasees of any and all claims or demands of every kind and nature that Licensee has claimed to have had at the time of this release or might have had, either known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, and Licensee shall not commence to prosecute, cause, or permit to be prosecuted, any action or proceeding of any description against the Releasees.

15. This Consent Order, when signed by both parties, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and may only be modified or amended by a subsequent document executed in the same manner by the parties.

16. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to deny the Board jurisdiction to investigate alleged violations of Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, or to investigate complaints received under Risk Management Laws, K.S.A. 65-4921 *et seq.*, that are known or unknown and are not covered under this Consent Order, or to initiate formal proceedings based upon known or unknown allegations of violation of the Kansas Healing Arts Act.

17. Licensee acknowledges he has read this Consent Order and fully understands the contents.

18. Licensee acknowledges that this Consent Order has been entered into freely and voluntarily.

19. Licensee further understands and agrees that upon adoption this document shall be deemed a public record and shall be reported to any entities authorized to receive disclosure of the Consent Order.

20. Licensee agrees that all information maintained by the Board pertaining to the nature and result of any complaint and/or investigation may be fully disclosed to and considered by the Board in conjunction with the presentation of any offer of settlement, even if Licensee is not present. Licensee further acknowledges that the Board may conduct further inquiry as it deems necessary before the complete or partial acceptance or rejection of any offer of settlement.

21. Licensee, by signature to this document, waives any objection to the participation of the Board members, including the Disciplinary Panel and General Counsel, in the consideration of this offer of settlement and agrees not to seek the disqualification or recusal of any Board member or General Counsel in any future proceedings on the basis that the Board member or General Counsel has received investigative information from any source which otherwise may not be admissible or admitted as evidence.

22. The Board may consider all aspects of this Consent Order in any future matter regarding Licensee.

23. Upon execution of this Consent Order by affixing a Board authorized signature below the provisions of this Consent Order shall become an Order under K.S.A. 65-2838. This Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Order when filed with the office of the Executive Director for the Board and no further Order is required.

24. This Consent Order constitutes **public disciplinary action.**

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PROBATION: LIMITATION

25. Licensee is hereby limited from performing male circumcisions until he completes training and observation of at least five (5) male circumcisions by a training/supervising physician.

26. Following completion of the above training and observation requirement, Licensee must successfully perform at least ten (10) male circumcisions under direct supervision of the training/supervising physician.

27. Prior to starting on the above-mentioned training and supervision requirement, Licensee shall submit a proposed training/supervising physician for approval by Disciplinary Panel #26. This training/supervising physician shall be a Kansas-licensed doctor of medicine and surgery or doctor of osteopathic medicine and surgery with an Active license, in good standing, has practiced for at least five (5) years), and who regularly performs male circumcisions. Licensee shall ensure such training/supervising physician shall submit to Disciplinary Panel #26 a current Curriculum Vitae and a written statement indicating they understand their responsibilities and obligations as Licensee's training/supervising physician.

28. The Board hereby appoints Disciplinary Panel #26 to approve/disapprove whether Licensee has satisfactorily completed the necessary requirements for the above license limitations to be lifted. It is Licensee's duty to provide whatever information is necessary for Disciplinary Panel #26 to make this decision.

29. All reports required pursuant to this Consent Order, all correspondence or communication between Licensee and the Board, and proof of completion of all requirements of this section shall be made in writing to:

30. Licensee shall obey all federal, state and local laws and rules governing the practice of medicine and surgery in Kansas which may be in place at the time of execution of this Consent Order or may become effective after the execution of this document.

LIMITATIONS TIMEFRAME

31. The above-mentioned practice limitations are not self-terminating. Upon Licensee's submission of proof of completion of this Consent Order's terms, and following review and approval by Disciplinary Panel #26, the Board's Compliance Coordinator shall provide notice of such approval and completion to the Clerk of the Board. Upon such notification, the terms of this Consent Order shall be deemed satisfied and the practice limitations shall be formally lifted and Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas shall be returned to full, unencumbered status by entry of a Journal Entry of Satisfaction, to be signed and approved by the Executive Director, without the necessity of further hearing or appearance before the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED this Consent Order and agreement of the parties contained herein is adopted by the Board as findings of fact, conclusions of law, and as a Final Order of the Board.

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
