CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW Disciplinary Panel No. 39 (“Petitioner”), by and through Jacob T. Overbey, Associate Litigation Counsel, and Ann G. Urquhart, P.T.A. (“Licensee”), pro se, and move the Board for approval of this Consent Order affecting Licensee’s license to practice as a physical therapist assistant in Kansas. The parties stipulate and agree to the following:

1. Licensee’s last known mailing address to the Board is: **CONFIDENTIAL**,

2. Licensee is, or has been at all times relevant hereto, actively licensed to practice as a physical therapist assistant in the State of Kansas, having originally been issued license No. 14-02893 on or around July 21, 2015. Licensee’s license status is currently “Active,” having last renewed on August 5, 2025.

3. The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) is the sole and exclusive administrative agency in the State of Kansas authorized to regulate the practice of physical therapist assistants. K.S.A. 65-2901 *et seq.*

4. The terms and conditions of the Consent Order are entered into between the undersigned parties and are submitted for the purpose of allowing these terms and conditions to

become an Order of the Board. This Consent Order shall not be binding on the Board until an authorized signature is affixed at the end of this document. Licensee specifically acknowledges that counsel for the Panel is not authorized to sign this Consent Order on behalf of the Board.

5. A protective order is hereby entered to protect all confidential information under 42 C.F.R. Part II, K.S.A. 65-2839(a)(d), K.S.A. 65-4915, and K.S.A. 65-2898(a).

6. Facts supporting the allegations in this Consent Order include, but are not limited to the following:

- a. In December 2023, Licensee submitted an application to renew her physical therapist assistant license. The renewal fee payment was returned for insufficient funds, and Licensee failed to remit payment despite multiple notices from Kansas.gov and the Board.
- b. During the Board's efforts to collect the unpaid renewal fees, Licensee sent hostile, profane, and threatening communications to a Board agent acting in an official capacity.
- c. Licensee also made public social media posts disparaging the Board and its staff and encouraging others to practice as physical therapists or physical therapist assistants without timely paying required licensing fees.

8. The Board has received information **CONFIDENTIAL**, and has reason to believe there are grounds to take action with respect to Licensee's license under the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-2901, *et seq.* Specifically:

- a. K.S.A. 65-2912(a)(5), as defined in K.A.R. 100-29-12(a)(7) and (a)(18), in that the board may limit, suspend or revoke the license of a licensee for engaging in unprofessional conduct, including conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public. To wit: Licensee publicly and privately harassed a public servant and agent of the Board while encouraging other individuals to obtain a license to practice as a physical therapist assistant without paying the fees as required by Kansas law.

K.S.A. 65-2912(a)(5), as further defined by K.A.R. 100-2912(a)(7), in that the board may limit, suspend or revoke the license of a licensee for engaging in unprofessional conduct, including failure to furnish to the board, its investigators, or representatives any information legally requested by the board. **CONFIDENTIAL**

9. Licensee acknowledges that the Board has sufficient evidence to prove that Licensee violated the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act with respect to the above allegations. Licensee further waives her right to dispute or otherwise contest the allegations contained in the above paragraphs in any further proceeding before the Board.

10. This Consent Order and the filing of such document are in accordance with applicable law, and the Board has jurisdiction to enter into the Consent Order as provided by

K.S.A. 77-505 and K.S.A. 65-2838. Upon approval, these stipulations shall constitute the findings of the Board, and this Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Final Order.

11. The Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act is constitutional on its face and as applied in this case. Licensee agrees that in considering this matter, the Board is not acting beyond its jurisdiction as provided by law.

12. Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives her right to a hearing. Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives her right to present a defense by oral testimony and documentary evidence, to submit rebuttal evidence, and to conduct cross-examination of witnesses. Licensee voluntarily and knowingly agrees to waive all possible substantive and procedural motions and defenses that could be raised if an administrative hearing were held.

13. As set forth in K.S.A. 65-2838(b) and K.S.A. 77-505, the Board has authority to enter into this Consent Order without the necessity of proceeding to a formal hearing.

14. All the materials **CONFIDENTIAL** regarding Licensee were fully reviewed and considered by the Board members who serve on the Board's Disciplinary Panel. Disciplinary Panel No. 39 authorized and directed Board counsel to seek settlement of this matter with the provisions contained in this Consent Order.

15. Licensee further understands and agrees that if the Board finds, after due written notice and an opportunity for a hearing, that Licensee has failed to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, the Board may immediately impose any sanction provided for by law, including but not limited to, suspension or revocation of Licensee's license to practice as a physical therapist assistant in the state of Kansas. Licensee expressly understands and agrees that, at any

such hearing, the sole issue shall be whether or not Licensee has failed to comply with any of the terms or conditions set forth in this Consent Order. The Board acknowledges that at any such hearing, Licensee retains the right to confront and examine all witnesses, present evidence, testify on her own behalf, contest the allegations, present oral argument, appeal to the courts, and all other rights set forth in the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, and the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-2901 *et seq.*

16. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to deny the Board jurisdiction to investigate alleged violations of the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act, or to investigate complaints received under Risk Management Laws, K.S.A. 65-4921 *et seq.*, that are known or unknown and are not covered under this Consent Order, or to initiate formal proceedings based upon known or unknown allegations of violation of the Kansas Physical Therapy Practice Act.

17. Licensee hereby releases the Board, its individual members (in their official and personal capacity), attorneys, employees, and agents (collectively, "Releasees"), from any and all claims including, but not limited to, those alleged damages, actions, liabilities, both administrative and civil, including the Kansas Judicial Review Act, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.*, arising out of the investigation and acts leading to the execution of this Consent Order. This release shall forever discharge the Releasees of any and all claims or demands of every kind and nature that Licensee has claimed to have had at the time of this release or might have had, either known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, and Licensee shall not commence to prosecute, cause, or permit to be prosecuted, any action or proceeding of any description against the Releasees.

18. Licensee further understands and agrees that upon signature by Licensee, this document shall be deemed a public record and shall be reported to any entities authorized to receive disclosure of the Consent Order.

19. This Consent Order, when signed by both parties, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may only be modified or amended by a subsequent document executed in the same manner by the parties.

20. Licensee agrees that all information maintained by the Board pertaining to the nature and result of any complaint and/or investigation may be fully disclosed to and considered by the Board in conjunction with the presentation of any offer of settlement, even if Licensee is not present. Licensee further acknowledges that the Board may conduct further inquiry as it deems necessary before acceptance or rejection of any offer of settlement.

21. Licensee, by signature to this document, waives any objection to the participation of the Board members, including the Disciplinary Panel and General Counsel, in the consideration of this offer of settlement and agrees not to seek the disqualification or recusal of any Board member or General Counsel in any future proceedings on the basis that the Board member or General Counsel has received investigative information from any source which otherwise may not be admissible or admitted as evidence.

22. Licensee acknowledges she has read this Consent Order and fully understands its contents and has been entered into freely and voluntarily.

23. Licensee shall obey all federal, state and local laws and rules governing the practice of physical therapist assistant in the State of Kansas which may be in place at the time of execution of this Consent Order or may become effective subsequent to the execution of this document.

24. Upon execution of this Consent Order by affixing a Board authorized signature below the provisions of this Consent Order shall become a Final Order under K.S.A. 77-526. This Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Order when filed with the office of the Executive Director for the Board and no further Order is required.

25. This Consent Order constitutes **public disciplinary action**.

26. The Board may consider all aspects of this Consent Order in any future matter regarding Licensee.

27. In lieu of conducting a formal hearing by the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), Licensee, by signature affixed to this Consent Order, hereby voluntarily agrees to the following public disciplinary action against her license to engage in the practice of physical therapist assistant.

PUBLIC CENSURE

28. This Consent Order shall constitute a **Public Censure** for the above noted unprofessional conduct.

31. Licensee shall immediately notify the Board or its designee of any citation, arrest or charge filed against her or of any conviction for any traffic or criminal offenses.

32. Licensee shall immediately notify the Board or its designee of any complaint filed, or investigation opened, by the proper licensing authority of another state, territory, District of

Columbia, or other country, or by a peer review body, a health care facility, a professional association or society, or by a governmental agency.

33. Licensee shall at all times keep Board staff informed of all her current practice locations, addresses and telephone numbers. Licensee shall provide the above information in writing to the Board within ten (10) days of any such change.

35. The above provisions are not self-terminating. This Consent Order shall terminate upon submission of written proof of successful completion and satisfaction of all conditions and requirements under this Consent Order, including but not limited to the successful completion of any monitoring or treatment deemed appropriate by SPS.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this Consent Order and agreement of the parties contained herein is hereby adopted by the Board as findings of fact, conclusions of law, and as a Final Order of the Board.
