

STIPULATION

This agreement, entered into this 14th day of December, 1982, by and between the Kansas Board of Healing Arts, by and through its Secretary, Helen Gilles, M.D., hereinafter referred to as the Board and John Drayton Conley, M.D., 2221 West Sixth Avenue, Topeka, Kansas, 66603, hereinafter referred to as Conley.

WHEREAS, that the question has arisen concerning Conley's being able to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas;

WHEREAS, Conley and the Board have met and discussed matters of concern to both parties on December 10, 1982, at the regularly scheduled Board Meeting;

WHEREAS, Conley is making application for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas;

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interests of all parties to grant licensure to Conley but with a specific requirement (confidential)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority invested in the Board by law the parties hereto desire to enter into a stipulation, the contents of which are as follows:

NOW, IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

A. That Conley should receive his license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas;

2. That within six months, or no later than June 10, 1983, Conley should institute an appointment to meet either the Board or its designee for purposes of discussing generally his progress and other matters of interest in the Board's discretion.


C. That both the Board and Conley fully understand that the conditions herein set forth are intended to be strictly construed and adhered to. That should any of the conditions herein not be fully met, this stipulation agreement will immediately become of no force and effect, and should it be considered necessary by the Board to institute formal proceedings against Conley, said administrative hearing proceedings will be prepared and filed all within the Board's discretion.

D. That there have been no other agreements or understandings regarding any matter in question herein other than what has been expressly set out. Further, this stipulation shall be in full force and effect until and unless either it is rescinded as above set forth by Conleys not adhering to the conditions set forth or it is modified by written agreement between the parties.

E. That at the expiration of the six months period above referred to, or June 10, 1983, should the above referred to conditions have been fully satisfied, the parties may agree to either extend the terms and conditions as appear in this stipulation or may terminate the stipulation so that it would of no force and effect, such agreement between the parties to be entered into for the purpose of effecting the best interests of both parties.
