ORDER DENYING SECOND TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW, on this 11th day of February 1989, comes on for consideration the application for a second temporary registration to provide patient services as a physician's assistant in the State of Kansas by endorsement filed by the above-named applicant (hereinafter referred to as "Applicant").

After considering the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board"), sitting at a regular meeting and serving as presiding officer in accordance with K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-538 and K.A.R. 100-19-1 finds as follows:

1. That the application for endorsement of Tammy Eby, P.A. to practice as a physician's assistant was received in the office of the Board on August 19, 1988.

2. That by letter dated August 29, 1988 applicant was advised that her application had been processed and said letter was to serve as temporary registration until March 15, 1989 and the results indicating Applicant has passed the National Certifying Examination for Physician's Assistants had been received.

3. That on February 8, 1989, the Board received a copy of Applicant's results of the 1988 Physician Assistant National Certifying Examination indicating that Applicant had not successfully passed the examination.

4. That by letter received in the Board office on February 8, 1989, Applicant requested an extension of the temporary registration to practice as a physician's assistant in the State of Kansas.

5. That K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 65-2896d provides that not more than one temporary permit shall be permitted without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. That at the regular meeting of the Board February 11,

1989, action was taken by the Board to not grant a second temporary registration to Applicant.


7. That Applicant's application for a second temporary registration to provide patient services as a physician's assistant in the State of Kansas should be denied for the reason that such was not approved by a majority of the members of the Board.

8. That Applicant is entitled to an administrative review of this Order Denying Second Temporary Permit if a written request is received in the board office within 15 days of service of this Order upon applicant.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the findings and conclusions hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board and Applicant's application for second temporary registration to provide patient services as a physician's assistant, filed in the board office on or about 2nd day of February 1989 is denied.
