

3. That at its meeting June 12, 1992 the Board ordered staff to take no action on Applicant's application for permanent license but that Applicant be given until December 12, 1992 to make renewed efforts to obtain documentation which would, as nearly as possible, meet the requirements of Section X of the aforementioned application, said efforts to include contact with the American Medical Association National Credentialing Verification Service (NCVS).

4. At its meeting June 12, 1992, the Board granted to Applicant temporary permit number 9249806 pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2811(a).

5. That on November 30, 1992, the Board office received a telephone call from Applicant indicating she had not contacted the NCVS or had not otherwise made efforts to obtain documentation to meet the requirements of Section X of the application for permanent licensure and further that she had applied for a medical license in the state of New York.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. That Applicant's request for waiver of Section X of the application for permanent license be denied and, based on Applicant's inability to fulfill the requirements of Section X of the application, the application for permanent license is denied.

C. That based on the denial of Applicant's application, temporary permit number 9249806 previously granted is cancelled and


no longer valid to authorize Applicant to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

D. This is an Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service of this Order file a Petition for Reconsideration. A Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
