ORDER OF DISMISSAL

NOW ON THIS 28th day of February, 1992 this
comes on matter *Jan 1-23-92* on for consideration of an **AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

submitted by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) and
Temporary Permit holder/ Respondent Paul Glynn, D.O. (Respondent).

The Board appears by and through its attorney, Steve A. Schwarm.

Respondent appears by and through his counsel of record, Joan M.
Jan 1-23-92 Hamilton. There are no other appearances.

Action taken at the Board meeting on December 14, 1992
encompassed the following:

"Moved to dismiss without prejudice the pending
administrative proceeding in opposition to application of
Paul ~~X~~ Glynn, D.O. for a license by endorsement;
Jan 1-23-92 approve application and forthwith issue a permanent license
to Dr. Glynn to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery
in the State of Kansas contingent upon Dr. Glynn
providing the Board a sworn statement that *Jan 1-23-92* ~~he~~ will not
raise any defenses, including but not necessarily limited
to waiver, estoppel, res judicata, or other affirmative
defenses to preclude the Board from further investigation
or initiation of proceedings in accordance with the Kansas
Administrative Procedures Act in the event the Missouri
State Board of Registration for the Healing Arts hereafter
takes disciplinary sanctions against Dr. Glynn for acts
or conduct which would constitute grounds for disciplinary
actions under K.S.A. 1990 Supp. 65-2837 as amended by L.

1991, Chapter 192, Section 2 or in the event the Board initiates disciplinary action independent of the State of Missouri."

Respondent Glynn has executed a "STATEMENT BY PAUL GLYNN, D.O." which addresses the contingency set forth by the Board in its action of December 14, 1991. Such STATEMENT is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein. (ATTACHMENT 1)

The Board agrees to issue a permanent license to engage in the practice of osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas to Respondent based on the above STATEMENT.

The parties have agreed that such dismissal of the pending administrative action shall be WITHOUT PREJUDICE.


There being no other matters before this Presiding Officer for consideration the following order is hereby issued:


